A handaxe was a rock tool used to chop at something. It was usually longer than a chopper and usually had a more defined edge of sharpness.



Worked edges

Sometimes early man would use part of an antler to hit the flakes off the rocks. This is part of a deer antler.

Chopper – A rock tool used in chopping wood, bones and a variety of other material worked edges



Chopper – Made from a rock called <u>Sugar white Quartzite</u>

A hammerstone was used to hit pieces (flakes) off the edge of this large rock leaving it with sharp and jagged edges. Only the front side of this rock was made into a worked edge. The bottom is completely flat letting it fit comfortably into your hand.
